Chandra X-ray Telescope Image
A black hole, at the center of this image, emits X rays, as explained in the other caption. The
Earth-orbiting Chandra X-Ray Observatory "sees" the X rays. Here they are displayed in a
color spectrum corresponding to the energy of the rays, highest energies being at the center,
inside which the black hole resides. This one is in the constellation Ursa Major.
